VISA Information	Visa Requirements: Citizens from the U.S., Canada, most of Europe, and many Latin American countries do not need a visa for stays of up to 90 days.

	If you hold a passport issued by the countries or territories listed under List A, B, or C, or those classified as Special Visa Exemption Cases, you may enter, stay, and leave Colombia without a visa for short-term activities (including business, leisure, tourism, or cultural interest), as long as these activities do not involve receiving payment for services, salary, or wages in Colombia. (Resolution 5488 of June 22, 2022, and Resolution 3717 of May 23, 2023)
